- Be prepared to provide samples of previous work.

Orientation/Training: Orientation package and an introduction to CPAWS offices and staff. Any information required for publications and outreach materials will be provided as needed on an ongoing basis.

Work with: You will work with all staff as projects are required for all staff areas (fundraising, events, outreach, etc).
